

Pasadena Roving Archers
Minutes
May 7, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 pm by President, Truett Sparkman.

The minutes of the PRA Board Meeting held April 2, 2008 were available for review.

Treasurer's Report Mike Burnham presented the Treasurer's Report.

Old Business

- Clean up day – May 17th There is still some need for clean up on the north side of the range. Odie will send a reminder e-mail asking everyone to bring weed whackers, hedge clippers and rakes. The workers are needed by 8am that day. The trails will be lined and targets will be put up that day too. Items needed to prepare the range: 3x5 cards, magic markers, postal tape and range finder.
- Oak Tree Event – May 18th Since the City of Pasadena will not allow any cooking, there was discussion regarding renting a generator, using hot plates versus warming plates, and making versus purchasing pre-made sandwiches. An e-mail will be sent to the membership to ask if anyone has a generator that could be used. Anne and Truett will check Costco for pricing of sandwiches. Anne has a crock pot that she offered for use for chili. She will check the wattage needed. Another crock pot would be great. It was also determined that a couple of water stations throughout the range were needed. The barbecue currently in storage will be brought to the range to see if it can be sold. Netting or plastic will be needed to keep food covered. Publicity has been sent to several pro shops. Eric offered to take flyers to Archery Sports in Simi Valley. Bob will pick up a check for the \$300 needed to purchase prizes. Joanne will order the portable toilets.
 - Volunteers needed for the day of the event:
 - Registration – 3 people 7:30 to 9am
 - Parking – 3 people 7:30 to 9am
 - Food - 5 people 7:30 am to 3pm could do 2 shifts 7:30-10 and 10-3
 - Scoring – 2 people 1 to 3pm
- State Field Championship – June 22, 2008 Truett has the score cards and anticipates receiving the targets any day. Three registrations have been received to date. Truett will verify that they will be sending animal targets.
- 501 (c) (3) Irene will need the check for the filing fee. Bob brought up the possibility of changing the fiscal year to July 1 to June 30th.
- Garage storage fee – The annual fee of \$600 is due now.
- Instruction program targets – a minimum of 12 D targets are needed. There was discussion as to the size of targets that students should be using for Saturday classes. Some smaller targets need to be used.
- Jeriel asked for approval to throw out several in-dirt arrow holders
